In the Renaissance Period (文艺复兴时期) (1500-1650), people became interested in higher education. They wanted to learn the a\_\_\_\_\_ languages such as Greek and Latin- languages that were used in the old times, and study mathematics, science, and so on. Many university were set up during the 16th century.

University education was a privilege (特权) of the rich. Girls were not allowed to attend and poor people could not a\_\_\_\_\_ to go. For the not so wealthy, grammar schools were built in towns. They learned basic grammar and mathematics, and took part in Bible study, At home, girls learned washing, cooking, dancing, and the basics of taking care of a household. Poor children r\_\_\_\_\_ attended school.

The Renaissance was a time when learners did not simply accept what they were old. They

did scientific experiments themselves to search for a \_\_\_\_\_ to the mysteries (神秘) of the space. Copernicus calculated that the Earth turned around the sun but was afraid to publish his works for fear that the Church would punish (惩罚) him. Galileo later supported this. The watch, the telescope and some others were some inventions of this period.

A new TV series in England, *Away from it all*, has surprised everyone by becoming a huge success with young people who live in the country. Its success is surprising because the series is about the relaxing lifestyles of people who live in the country. There is none of the action that we usually see on TV today. There are also no stressful (有压力的) moments, busy officers or crowded cities. *Away from it all* is set in the peaceful English countryside and tells the simple stories about people's kindness.

The director of the TV series says that its success is a sign of teenagers suffering from stress. They say that watching *Away from it all* helps teenagers forget about the pressure (压力) of exam, homework and the troubles that fill the world today. They also say that it's a good sign of today's young people turning to happier TV series as it shows they would like a happier and healthier world.

Although the series success might have a good side, many teachers and parents are worried, however. They say that some of their students and children are becoming couch potatoes (终日泡在电视机前的人) and are using *Away from it all* as an excuse for not completing homework. Some children have even refused to learn for exams because they say that they can't achieve personal happiness until they keep away from stressful situations completely.

And what do the scientists say? Paula Ray, a director of education, says that TV can bring changes to children's lifestyles. But she says that if a child reacts strongly, it's likely that there are other reasons for his change in behavior (行为). She says that there is nothing wrong with watching *Away from it all*, but suggests that parents should make sure their children know TV is not the same as real life.
